# **Presidents report**

Springston Pony Club

# President's End of Year Report 2016 Christine Lewis February 2017

#### **Membership and Rallies**

Springston PC had a large number of new members during the year, and finished the year with membership of 49 riding members and 31 adults, up on the 41 riding members at the end of 2015. We have a good mix of ages and capabilities from lead rein to seniors, although a little bit light on the older seniors.

We put aside \$4000 for coaching for the year, and trialled separating the rallies with a Junior and Senior rally coordinator and a separate focus on certificates. Each group held a planning meeting at the start of the year. There were 24 junior rallies held, with certificate work, as well as special fun rallies such as Carts, West Melton Forest Ride, 2 road rides, Spencer Park Beach Ride, Christmas games, a dress up rally and Easter events, and two games rallies. We started a programme for the Juniors to earn the NZPCA badges as an addition to the certificate work. There were ten senior rallies held with specialist coaches in dressage, SJ, and certificate work. A number of HM evening sessions were held for all certificate levels, which has contributed to our high number of certificates this year.

We collected feedback towards the end of the year, and found that this worked well, especially for the seniors who had monthly rather than fortnightly rallies, and were able to focus on targeted coaching. The downside was that the juniors didn't get to see the seniors and have them as role models, and for the seniors who wanted fortnightly rallies, there were not the coaches available at the junior rallies. Therefore for the coming year we have recommended that we get the best of both worlds, with fortnightly rallies available for all, but with some additional targeted rallies for the seniors.

The Zone 5 games (Central South Island ) was held on February 19th, and run by ASCNO Pony Club at Methven Show Grounds. Springston had two pairs entries for the Junior pairs – Amy and Ellen, and Gemma, Georgia and Jack H. Games for the pairs were Speed Weavers, 3 Mug, Toolbox Scramble, , Ball and Cone, Agility Aces, Bottle Race, and Two Flag – Tie Breaker. Each race was timed, with two heats of six pairs. Out of the 12 entries, Amy and Ellen came 3<sup>rd</sup> and Gemma, Georgia and Jack 6<sup>th</sup>. Natalie also competed in the Open pairs in a composite pair, and was a real credit to Springston with her encouraging attitude to her more inexperienced partner. # **Selection policy**

# Springston Pony Club - Team Selection Policy 2017

This policy deals with selection of all Springston Pony Club teams. The policy will ensure all riders are capable of the task for which they are being selected, in the view of the selectors (who may take input from parents and coaches), and ensure that teams are selected in an open fair process. The overall goal is to select the strongest first team, and then further teams for experience and participation of members.

#### **Selection Policy**

For the teams the highest ranked riders (with specified horse / pony) in each discipline will become a team member with the next highest taking the next position and so forth until all the places in the team are filled. Reserves may be named. The highest ranking of the riders will be first team, second team then reserves; this means if a rider has to withdraw the next ranking rider below moves up. At times selectors, with the permission of riders and their parent/s, may ask a rider to ride up an age group to make the strongest team.

Riders must be financial members of the branch at the time of selection. To be eligible for any team competition, riders must comply with the Pony Club rules of rally attendance. Members having more than one horse / pony should nominate which horse / pony they are trying out for selection with, and may nominate more than one horse / pony.

If a rider's horse / pony goes lame, the selectors will select the next most qualified reserve. (Note - a rider with more than one horse / pony may not automatically substitute another horse / pony. This decision will be made by the selectors in accordance with the selection policy).

Springston branch may endeavour to create a composite team made up of riders from other branches / clubs, but all Springston PC members will be ranked higher (in their age group or section) than outside riders and will always have preference over riders from another branch /club, irrespective of ability (provided that the selectors consider the rider is capable of competing safely at the required level).

Many teams events may require additional training, practices and/or meetings. Every effort will be made by the coach to find suitable times for these. Putting your name forward for selection is agreement to do your best to attend and participate in ALL of these. There may be times were there is additional cost for training. This cost will be paid for by the member. Failure to attend may result in your withdrawal from this team and/or future teams at the selectors discretion. Payment of entry fees for the selected teams event will be paid by Springston Pony Club. Any additional costs (eg travel, accommodation, training) will be paid for by the member.

#### **Informing the riders**

Once the selection committee has reached their decision, it goes to the Springston PC Committee for ratification. Once ratified, those rider(s) missing on selection will be the first informed, and when all have been contacted, the riders selected will then be informed. Any questions regarding selection should be made to the Selection Committee Chair (not directly to the selectors). The selectors decision is final, and so long as it is in accordance with this Policy, no changes will be made. It is the responsibility of the member to provide all pertinent information (results etc) to the selectors before the selection date. Every effort will be made by the selectors to select the team and notify riders of selection four weeks in advance of the competition date (except for Springston Trophy where it is 7 weeks in advance).

# **Missing Selection**

Those that miss out on selection, but have qualified under the rules of the competition will be encouraged and supported to obtain a position to ride for another team should they choose.

#### **Process**

The results from ALL related internal and external competitions over the previous 12 months and any other pertinent information should be submitted by the rider and will be taken into account. A trial may be held.

#### **Eventing**

Team selection will be based on the results and scores at eventing competitions from the past 12 months. Riders are expected to have at least two live scores at eventing competitions at the required heights for age in the previous 12 months. Results from dressage and show jumping competitions may also be taken into account in some circumstances.

#### Games

Selection will be based on skills at competition, training sessions and trials. A games trial can be run and timed. Performance as part of a team (rather than just as an individual) will also be taken into account.

### Dressage

Team selection will be based on results and scores at competitions. Dressage only competitions take precedence however the dressage phase of a combined training or eventing competitions should be included. All results from the last 12 months at these competitions will be taken into account. *Show Jumping* 

Team selection will be based on results and scores at competitions. Show jumping only competitions take precedence however the show jumping phase of a combined training or eventing competition should be included. All results from the last 12 months at these competitions will be taken into account.

#### Dressage and Jumping

Team selection will be based on results and scores at competitions. Results from dressage only, show jumping only, combined training, dressage and jumping, and dressage and show jumping sections of eventing competitions should be included. All results from the last 12 months at these competitions will be taken into account.

#### For all selections

Riders need to keep account of all internal and external competitions they attend with their results, and comment. This should be done via the Springston Pony Club record card. This record card should be copied and made available to the selectors by the date specified for selection. The onus is on the rider to ensure their record care is complete, accurate and presented on time. Other pertinent information should also be presented. The selectors will notify members via email, newsletter and/or at rallies of the closing dates for applications for team events.

# **Health and Safety**

We are all responsible for Health and Safety.

There is a hazard register on the clubroom door. Please have a look at this and contact myself (<a href="mailto:Pauline\_jarvis@hotmail.com">Pauline\_jarvis@hotmail.com</a>) or a committee member with any suggestions.

A fall register needs to be filled in for ALL falls (even if the rider lands on their feet and pops straight back on). There is a more detailed form if medical or veterinary treatment is required. A human and horse first aid kit is available in the clubrooms. Please replace any items used.

#### **Helmets**

We wish to remind all riders that as of August 1st 2017 some helmets will no longer be accepted for ESNZ or NZPCA competitions. If you have an old helmet with the EN1384 or the BSEN 1384 standards you must look to purchase a new helmet with the acceptable helmet standard.

PAS 015, Snell E2001, VG1 and AS/NZS 3838 are the required standards. These helmets will be tagged with red tags.

#### **Back protectors**

A reminder that if you want to jump at Pony Club, you are required to be wearing a back protector. It is recommended that you put this on before you get on at the beginning of the rally. Unfortunately your instructor will have to ask you to watch if the group are jumping and you don't have a back protector on.

# Water jump

# Saddlery shops

If you are buying gear at any of the local saddlery shops, please tell them that you are from Springston Pony Club. At the end of the year they donate vouchers to us relating to the amount our members spend. We use these for the end of year Christmas party, prizes etc.

#### **Grounds coordinator**

Please ensure that all horse manure is picked up from the arenas and the grounds before you leave. There is a wheelbarrow and rake available, so there are no excuses.

Please also ensure all show jumping rails are picked up off the ground. Even if you didn't drop them please pick them up so we can keep them in good condition for as long as we can.

Please keep an eye out for "happenings" at the grounds, if you see something which shouldn't be happening, please let a committee member know ASAP.
