Health and Safety







We are all responsible for Health and Safety.

There is a hazard register on the clubroom door. Please have a look at this and contact myself (Pauline_jarvis@hotmail.com) or a committee member with any suggestions.

A fall register needs to be filled in for ALL falls (even if the rider lands on their feet and pops straight back on). There is a more detailed form if medical or veterinary treatment is required. A human and horse first aid kit is available in the clubrooms. Please replace any items used.

About a year ago the standards for riding helmets at Pony Club (and ESNZ) changed. These come into effect from 1st August 2017. **If your helmet has ONLY the old standards, EN 1384 or BSEN 1384 it is not acceptable for use at pony club (including competitions) after 31st July 2017.**

This is a summary of the standards available

AS/NZS 3838 1998, 2003 or 2006		All Activities

After 1st August 2017 helmets will need a red sticker (to replace the current blue sticker) certifying compliance with the current standards. The Chief Instructor (Jo Benison) is authorized to inspect and place the new red sticker on helmets.

Saddlery shops

If you are buying gear at any of the local saddlery shops, please tell them that you are from Springston Pony Club. At the end of the year they donate vouchers to us relating to the amount our members spend. We use these for the end of year Christmas party, prizes etc.

Use of grounds

Springston Pony Club members are welcome to use the grounds free of charge (please ensure you have paid your subs!). The combination code is sent to members, please do NOT share this. Non-members need to pay for each visit (even if they come with you!). Bookings are available with Katie Meyer, ph 027 538 7277. Please be aware that other people may be using the grounds. Please book with Katie if it is important.

Please ensure that all horse manure is picked up from the arenas and the grounds before you leave. There is a wheelbarrow and rake available, so there are no excuses.

Please also ensure all show jumping rails are picked up off the ground. Even if you didn't drop them please pick them up so we can keep them in good condition for as long as we can.
