Unfortunately one of our senior riders, Natalie Peoples, had to withdraw a week before the event due to horse injury which was very disappointing for Natalie. But Natalie came to all 4 days of the event and she was just fantastic team support and so cheerful to have around, you are a real credit to our Pony Club Natalie, thank you so much for coming to support the team. Of our 8 riders competing, 5 were competing at Springston Trophy for the first time so this was a very new and exciting experience for many of our riders. We had a lovely fine day for dressage and all put in a good effort so we were sitting 12th (Springston team) and 17th (Springston-Amberley team) out of 39 teams after the dressage.

Cross country and show jumping days were very wet but all the riders coped very well with the wet conditions. The cross country course was challenging but it was a very well built course and a good test of the riders. All the riders put in their best efforts but sometimes things don't always go to plan and we had 4 eliminations on cross country with one having a swim in the water jump - but she still came out smiling! It was great to see the juniors grow in confidence and see the smile on their faces as they achieved their goals. Everyone enjoyed themselves, the junior riders in particular were thrilled with what they had learned and the experience gained.

Gear and uniform

We have noticed that we are missing quite a bit of Games gear, if you may have "borrowed" some of this, or if you know where it is, please return it – no questions asked.

Please be aware that unless it has been pre-approved by the committee, no gear, games, jumping, dressage, flags, numbers etc may be removed from the grounds.

We are also missing a few items of SPC uniform, eg brow bands, hat covers and covers. If you have used any gear and not returned it to your manager, or you are the manager and gear has not been returned, please return it now, or let a committee member know. Again, no questions asked, we would just like it back.

Attendance

As many of you are aware we take the attendance at each rally. This can be important if members would like to compete in teams events, or members only events.

To ensure that we reduce the risk of anyone being missed off the attendance register, we will trial sending out the rally attendance each rally so that if there are any problems these can be rectified immediately. When these are sent out, please could you check that your rider is on the register and their horse/pony name is correct. You will need to contact us immediately if this is not the case (within a few days), so we can follow it up with the rally coordinator, instructor etc and get it sorted out. A month or two later will be too late.

Saddlery shops

If you are buying gear at any of the local saddlery shops, please tell them that you are from Springston Pony Club. At the end of the year they donate vouchers to us relating to the amount our members spend. We use these for the end of year Christmas party, prizes etc.

Use of grounds

Springston Pony Club members are welcome to use the grounds free of charge (please ensure you have paid your subs!). The combination code is sent to members, please do NOT share this. Non-members need to pay for each visit (even if they come with you!). Bookings are available with Katie Meyer, ph 027 538 7277. Please be aware that other people may be using the grounds. Please book with Katie if it is important.

Please ensure that all horse manure is picked up from the arenas and the grounds before you leave. There is a wheelbarrow and rake available, so there are no excuses.

Please also ensure all show jumping rails are picked up off the ground. Even if you didn't drop them please pick them up so we can keep them in good condition for as long as we can.
