Riders just ride the tests that they are entered for and take their best test % for the team. Springston PC has job of building the show jumping. 
Each Friday at 5pm we can sell meat raffles at the pub. All that is needed is to turn up, Jo or Ange (bar staff) will give you the jug with tickets and you just go round the pub selling them. In fact they sell themselves! \$2 a ticket and most everyone buys the same ticket number in each raffle (there are two different coloured tickets, so 6 draws). You always sell to the patrons at the bar first then tables. Then once sold you give the ticket stubs and money back to the bar staff and they do the draw, Jo also has the meat packs there. Health and Safety

We are all responsible for Health and Safety.

There is a hazard register on the clubroom door. Please make yourself familiar with this and contact a committee member with any suggestions.

A fall register needs to be filled in for ALL falls (even if the rider lands on their feet and pops straight back on). There is a more detailed form if medical or veterinary treatment is required.

New concussion documents

NZPCA have developed some new concussion documents. These are available on the NZPCA website, under the health and safety section. http://www.nzpca.org/rules-regulations/health-safety

There is a new "Green Card" which is to be issued when a rider falls and has a suspected concussion. This Green Card means that the rider must go and be assessed by a registered medical practitioner and cleared before they can compete in pony club activities again. The 21 days stand down period for riders stands unless they have a medical certificate showing that they have been cleared to ride.

Note we do not have any "casual riding members", any causal riders (non-members) need to pay \$10 per horse/pony each time they come.
