Collier Trophy is a teams ODE competition and was run this year by Okuku PC and held at McLeans Island NEC on 27th May.

The Springston team was Seniors (80cm) - Katherine Hadler and Gemma Lewis

Intermediates (65cm) – Emily Holder and Stella Williams Juniors (65cm) – Sonya Benison and Georgia Lewis Riding in the Roydvale team as a Junior was Jaimee Adams.

Bad luck to Raewyn Adams – who was selected in the Springston team – but due to a fall and concussion, had to pull out.

The Springston riders performed well in their dressage with the team coming in 2nd place after dressage (out

of 22 teams) with Georgia winning her class, and Gemma and Sonya getting 2nd in their classes, Katherine coming 4th and Emily coming 6th. All team members jumped clear in the SJ phase, and with some good clear XC rounds from Gemma, Emily, Sonya and Stella we managed to hold onto 4th place overall. Sonya won her class overall, Gemma was 2nd, and Emily 5th. It was a great team effort with all of the team finishing on live scores, and really supporting each other – especially around the XC (we could hear a chorus of go



xxxxxxx or well done xxxxx as each rider rode around). The team looked very smart in their Springston colours and brand new rugs (which we definitely needed on a very cold day).

Health and Safety

We are all responsible for Health and Safety.

There is a hazard register on the clubroom door. Please make yourself familiar with this and contact a committee member with any suggestions.

A fall register needs to be filled in for ALL falls (even if the rider lands on their feet and pops straight back on). There is a more detailed form if medical or veterinary treatment is required.

New concussion documents

NZPCA have developed some new concussion documents. These are available on the NZPCA website, under the health and safety section. http://www.nzpca.org/rules-regulations/health-safety

There is a new "Green Card" which is to be issued when a rider falls and has a suspected concussion. This Green Card means that the rider must go and be assessed by a registered medical practitioner and cleared before they can compete in pony club activities again. The 21 days stand down period for riders stands unless they have a medical certificate showing that they have been cleared to ride.

Team Gear

Please could team Managers Liaise with Jo, the team gear person, and sign out and in all team gear used for team events.

SPC Events for this year

Please note that the SPC ODE is 21st-22nd July 2018. We will need EVERYONE to help with both the set up before and on these days. These dates should be in your diary now. Look out for an e-mail asking which jobs you would like to do, get in quick, or you will be allocated something.

Saddlery shops

If you are buying gear at any of the local saddlery shops, please tell them that you are from Springston Pony Club. At the end of the year they donate vouchers to us relating to the amount our members spend. We use these for the end of year Christmas party, prizes etc.

Grounds coordinator

We need a Grounds Person – someone who can co-ordinate what needs to be done on the grounds, they don't have to do all the work. This can involve working within a budget to pay someone to do what is required. Please contact Christine or Sharon R if you can help.

Use of grounds

Springston Pony Club members are welcome to use the grounds free of charge (please ensure you have paid your subs!). The combination code is sent to members, please do NOT share this. Non-members need to pay for each visit (even if they come with you!). Bookings are available with Katie Meyer, ph 027 538 7277.

Please ensure that all horse manure is picked up from the arenas and the grounds before you leave. There is a wheelbarrow and rake available, so there are no excuses.

Please also ensure all show jumping rails are picked up off the ground. Even if you didn't drop them please pick them up so we can keep them in good condition for as long as we can.

Please keep an eye out for "happenings" at the grounds, if you see something which shouldn't be happening, please let a committee member know ASAP.

Note we do not have any "casual riding members", any causal riders (non-members) need to pay \$10 per horse/pony each time they come.
