Class 1: NZPC 80 cm* ESNZ Eventing Dressage Test L2 (2009)
Class 2: NZPC 65 cm ESNZ Eventing Dressage Test L1 (2009)

Sunday 23rd July:

Class 3: NZPC 110 cm ESNZ Eventing Dressage Test B3 (2009)
Class 4: NZPC 105 cm* ESNZ Eventing Dressage Test A2 (2009)
Class 5 NZPC 95 cm* ESNZ Eventing Dressage Test A1 (2009)
Class 6: NZPC 80 cm ESNZ Eventing Dressage Test L2 (2009).

Classes may be divided into age groups once entries are closed.

The number of entries are limited for all classes. A waitlist will be opened once classes are full.

The 110cm class will only run if there are sufficient entries (a full refund, minus EE fee, will be given if there are not enough entries to run the class).

Springston Trophy Trialists: where classes are split, we will endeavour to place riders from the same pony club in the same class. Please ensure that EvoEvents is up to date with rider's pony club.

Yards and camping available: Only to those who have booked!

Uncovered Yard/Covered Yard/Stable: \$12/\$30/\$40 per day

Camping Unpowered/Powered site: \$10/\$25 per truck/campervan per night

(Note: Yards not left clean will incur an additional penalty charge of \$20 as per NEC charges.)

Watch My Ride

Watch My Ride will be making videos of the cross-country phases on Saturday and Sunday.

Conditions of Entry:

- 1. This competition is run under NZPCA and ESNZ eventing rules.
- 2. Riders (Parent/Guardian) by submitting an entry means you will abide by the conditions of entry. Springston Pony Club accept no responsibility for injury, loss or damage to property, horse or pony, rider or spectator.
- 3. Any rider who has suffered a concussion within 21 days of competition may not compete.
- 4. RIDING HELMETS shall be NZPCA approved with a red tag or yellow tag and are to be worn at all times while MOUNTED.
- 5. BACK PROTECTORS shall be NZPCA approved with a red tag and are compulsory for the cross-country phases.
- 6. Gear check is required for all phases for 65 and 80cm; 95cm compulsory gear check for XC only with random checks for dressage and show jumping. Random gear check for all phases for 105 & 110cm.
- 7. Correct attire for all phases. Pony Club uniform acceptable. Long hair must be tied up.
- 8. Dressage tests can be called for the 65cm and 80cm classes only.
- 9. Whips are not permitted in dressage phase, but spurs can be worn.
- 10. Disciplinary action will be taken if any person for abuse or serious mistreatment of a horse pony including excessive use of the whip or spurs.
- 11. Printed back numbers will NOT be provided. Please print and bring your own back numbers/back number holder.
- 12. Prize giving will be held approximately 30 minutes after the posting of final class scores providing there are no protests. Protests must be submitted to the event secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the incident and accompanied by \$30 which will be returned if protest upheld.
- 13. Prizes must be collected by the end of the event on Sunday, or they will be forfeited.
- 14. Withdrawals, Substitutions and Refunds:

Notifications of withdrawal from an event must be given to the Event Secretary prior to the commencement of the event. If a Horse is withdrawn prior to the closing date for entries, the entry fee (minus EE fee) will be refunded in full.

If a horse/rider is withdrawn after the closing date for entries and prior to the commencement of the event, 80% of the entry fee (minus EE fee) will be refunded upon the production of a Veterinary or Medical Certificate.

Horses may be substituted up to the closing date for entries via EvoEvents.

Riders may be substituted up to the closing date for entries via EvoEvents.

Substitution of horses and riders after the closing date for entries and prior to the start of the event will be at the organising committee's discretion.

- 15. The event will be held wet or fine. In the unlikely event of a cancellation, for example, due to extreme weather conditions or a natural disaster, all riders will be notified via email and a notification will be posted on the Springston Pony Club Facebook page the night prior. In the event of cancellation, \$70 of the entry fee will be refunded.
- 16. St John Ambulance will be on site both days.
- 17. A vet will be onsite for cross country on Sunday for the 105 & 110 classes and will be on call for the remainder of both days.
- 18. No class changes will be accepted on the day.
- 19. If eliminated you may NOT continue and must walk back.
- 20. Keep parking area clean and tidy and use area provided for manure.
- 21. All riders must provide a volunteer.
